

Advanced level position for Lead Carpenter

Job Description

We are looking for a Lead Carpenter with a strong work ethic, a professional appearance and demeanor, and a good overall knowledge of all trades—from Carpentry, Tiling, Painting, and Dry walling to light Plumbing and Electrical. The position is an advanced level position with responsibility for building, repairing, renovating, installing, modifying, and maintaining buildings, structures and other facilities. Performs and oversees preventive maintenance of designated building(s) and structural components.

Job Requirements

Candidates must be able to read and interpret blueprints, schematics, and technical manuals in performing repairs and installation activities. Candidates should be able to demonstrate precision measuring, cutting and fitting skills. Candidates should display solid communication and interpersonal abilities, and the ability to interact within a wide variety of different types of facilities in a positive way with customers, fellow employees, management, and office personnel. Performs both framing and finish work. Responsible for painting and staining woodwork and furniture; maintains brick/masonry walls; removes and replaces walls, door panels, blackboards, carpeting, builds cabinets. Hangs sheet rock, acoustical ceiling systems, paneling and baseboards. Repairs and adjusts doors, including automatic doors; repairs and replaces locks; maintains the shop, machinery, and equipment. Receives work orders; ascertain service needed, prepares material used; and may distributes work accordingly to others.

Requisitions supplies, parts, equipment and other related items; makes recommendations for future projects and equipment needs. Provides leadership and guidance with other staff members completing projects to ensure deadlines are met and projects completed within budget allocation. Works independently and, as an integral part of a Team may assist others.

Follows established safety rules and regulations and maintains a safe and clean environment. Functions in a lead capacity and perform supervisory duties in absence of the Manager. Performs related duties as assigned.

- Associates degree plus one year of experience as a carpenter and one year experience in two of the facilities trade areas

- Advanced skills in the use of tools and equipment, such as saws, drill press, drills, routers and sanders, etc.
- Ability to interpret blueprints; to organize preventive maintenance programs.

- Advanced knowledge of building codes.
- Ability to communicate effectively and courteously with individuals from diverse backgrounds.

- Strong knowledge and experience will be required.
